Terms and Conditions

- 1) Rates are net and are not commissionable. Rates do not include fuel and security, screening fee or any other surcharges and taxes.
- 2) Unless specified above, the following specific commodities are excluded from these rates: human remains; articles of extraordinary value; live animals, foodstuffs including but not limited to seafood, meats, fruits and vegetables; cut flowers; plants; nursery stock; seeds; and mixed shipments.
- 3) Charges will be based on the applicable net rate multiplied by the chargeable weight of the shipment and subject to minimum requirements.
- 4) Tariff rules apply to all shipments; domestic or international.
- 5) The air waybill must always be used and completed in its entirety.
- 6) Shipper is responsible for ensuring:
 - a) The Shipper's Delta account number is entered in the "Shipper Account Number" block of the air waybill.
 - b) A product has been selected in the "Service Description" block (DASH, Standard, DASH Heavy, PetFirst, Other). Only one product can be selected per air waybill.
 - c) The SCR Commodity Code is placed in the "Commodity Item Number" section of the air waybill when applicable.
- 7) Transborder shipments require an international air waybill. Rates not applicable between points in Canada.
- 8) Routes are subject to change without prior notice; discontinuance of service to any point shall nullify rates to or from that point.
- 9) Shipments of articles subject to IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations and/or Dry Ice will be assessed additional surcharges.
- 10) The maximum weight per piece for transportation on a narrow body aircraft is 300 lbs (136 kgs).
- 11) The maximum weight for an E container is 200 lbs (91 kgs).
- 12) Rates are applicable to Standard service only. For DASH Heavy, a 70% premium applies.
- 13) Rates are subject to change without prior notice.
- 14) DASH Heavy minimum charge: \$102.00
- 15) DASH Heavy minimum charge for Canada origin: 127.50 (CAD).
