## SPECIAL HANDLING

Delta Cargo will, upon request, check dry ice levels and container temperature.

Shipments are kept in a secure storage area within the cargo facility.

Dangerous Goods, including dry ice, are accepted by specially trained Dangerous Goods Acceptance Agents.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Pharma 2 is Delta Cargo's solution for pharmaceutical products requiring a temperature controlled environment between +2°C to +8°C (+36°F to +46°F).

This solution is ideal for medicines in tablet or aerosol form, raw materials for drug manufacturing and biotechnology products. It is Cool Chain transport for commodities packed in containers utilizing a passive temperature controlled environment.

## BOOKING

Pharma 2 must be booked by calling the Delta Cargo Call Center at 1.800.352.2746. If you are outside the U.S., please contact your local Delta Cargo sales office.

## SHIPPING TIPS

- Tender shipments at least 180 minutes prior to flight departure.
- Be sure the shipment is properly packaged.
- Ensure that all documentation is complete.

## PACKING

- Use the right coolant for the transit time and the appropriate container.
- Minimize the time between packing and shipment.
- Comply with all government regulations. They vary from state to state and are the shipper's responsibility.
- Pack shipments in such a manner to avoid damage to people or equipment when transported under normal circumstances.

## DROP OFF / PICK UP

Your shipments may be dropped off and picked up at the local Delta Cargo facility.

## RESTRICTIONS

Pharma 2 shipments must be pre-booked and should be tendered 180 minutes prior to flight departure. Dimensions and weight must not exceed aircraft limitations. Individual carrier restrictions (i.e. size, weight, specific commodities, cities served, etc.) shall apply when transportation is routed on Delta Connection Carriers.

Dangerous Goods shipments are only accepted at certain cargo facilities. A complete list of these facilities may be found on [deltacargo.com](http://deltacargo.com).

IATA Time & Temperature Sensitive labels, if used, should have no markings/writing.

## DOCUMENTATION

Each piece of the shipment must be legibly and durably marked with the name and address of the shipper and consignee. Old labels and markings must be removed or obliterated.

Air waybill must reflect "No Value Declared."

Shipments should be clearly labeled.

## REGULATIONS

All international shipments will follow IATA rules for shipping.

All Dangerous Goods shipments will follow IATA Dangerous Goods regulations including shipments containing dry ice. You are responsible for compliance with those regulations.
